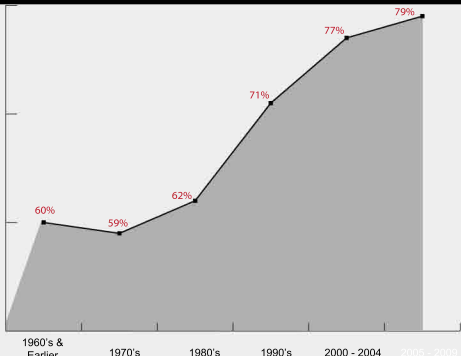


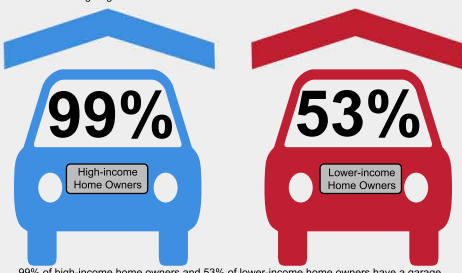
The Average American Garage

Percentage of Homes with Garage by Year

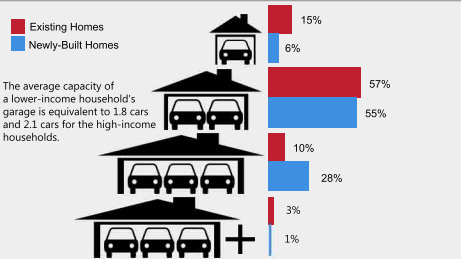


A recent survey shows 84% of single-family homes in the U.S. have garage.

 4 out of 5 garages are attached to the home.

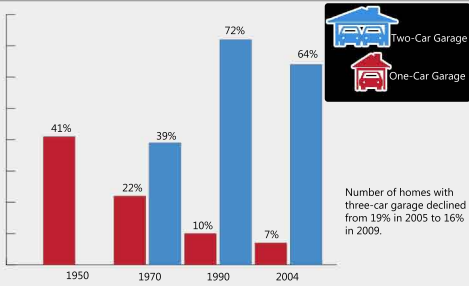


Garage Sizes

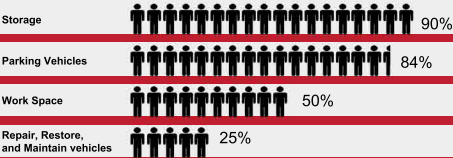
New & Existing Single-Family Homes with Garage in 2011

74% of homebuyers cited the garage as the most important amenity
